

TO BE KNOWN TO BE YOU







BY AIR:

London Gatwick Airport is I hour by road. London Heathrow and Stansted Airports are I.5 hours away.

BY RAIL:

London is one hour by train from Marden station (three miles away), from where there is a half-hourly service to London Charing Cross. Ebbsfleet and Ashford International Stations are 50 minutes by road and the Eurotunnel Terminal is one hour away.

BY ROAD:

From A21 London Sevenoaks Hastings. Exit at the junction for Goudhurst (A262). In the centre of Goudhurst turn left at the pond towards Marden (B2079). After about two miles of winding road, turn right on to Curtisden Green Lane, then right again on to Jarvis Lane. The entrance to the School is on your right.

FROM MAIDSTONE:

Take the A229 towards Hastings. After descending a steep hill at Linton, proceed for one mile and turn right towards Marden (B2079) and continue into Marden village. At the t-junction turn right towards Goudhurst. Three miles on, at the crest of the hill, turn left on to Curtisden Green Lane and then right on to Jarvis Lane. The entrance to the School is on your right.

FROM ASHFORD:

From Ashford take the A28 towards Tenterden. About a mile beyond High Halden turn right towards Biddenden and Tunbridge Wells (A262). In the centre of Biddenden turn left into Sissinghurst, staying on the A262. At the roundabout one mile beyond Sissinghurst take the second exit towards Goudhurst. In the centre of Goudhurst turn right at the pond towards Marden on the B2079. After about two miles of winding road, turn right on to Curtisden Green Lane and right again on to Jarvis Lane. The entrance to the School is on your right.

FROM CRANBROOK:

Take the A229 from Cranbrook towards Staplehurst. At the roundabout take the first exit towards Goudhurst (A262). In the centre of Goudhurst turn right at the pond towards Marden on the B2079. After about two miles of winding road, turn right on to Curtisden Green Lane and right again on to Jarvis Lane. The entrance to the School is on your right.
